CHILD CARE ASSISTANCE

Eligible participants can obtain county assistance in paying approximately ½ of a day care bill. Childcare assistance can most often be combined with scholarships or other grant/financial assistance programs offered through childcare centers. Applications available for MN & ND*

MN residents can complete applications with the Office of Scholarship & Financial Aid

HEAD START AND COMMUNITY SCHOLARSHIPS

Community Action Lakes and Prairies offers head start programs and for eligible households can be care provided at no cost. Households participating in Head Start may also remain eligible for child care assistance or grants. CAP-LP has additional grant based programs that can provided funding/vouchers to assist with childcare costs for eligible households.

South Eastern North Dakota Community Action offers head start programs for eligible households as well as grant based childcare programs.

OTHER COMMUNITY RESOURCES

Cass & Clay YMCA offers childcare, after school programs, summer programs, as well as, financial assistance.

ABC123 Daycare offers extended hours childcare, accepts childcare assistance and has additional scholarship opportunities.
