

International Student Hy Flex Course(s) Agreement Form

For F-1 students enrolled in classes for credit or classroom hours, no more than the equivalent of one class or three credits per semester may be counted toward the full course of study requirement if the class is taken online or through distance education and does not require the student's physical attendance for classes, examination or other purposes integral to the completion of the course.

An online or distance education course is a course that is offered principally through the use of television, audio, or computer transmission, including open broadcast, closed circuit, cable, microwave, or satellite, audio conferencing, or computer conferencing.

Minnesota State University Moorhead offers Hy Flex courses. In the Hy Flex course, students can choose to participate in the course "In-Person/Face to Face class session" or remote asynchronous options.
